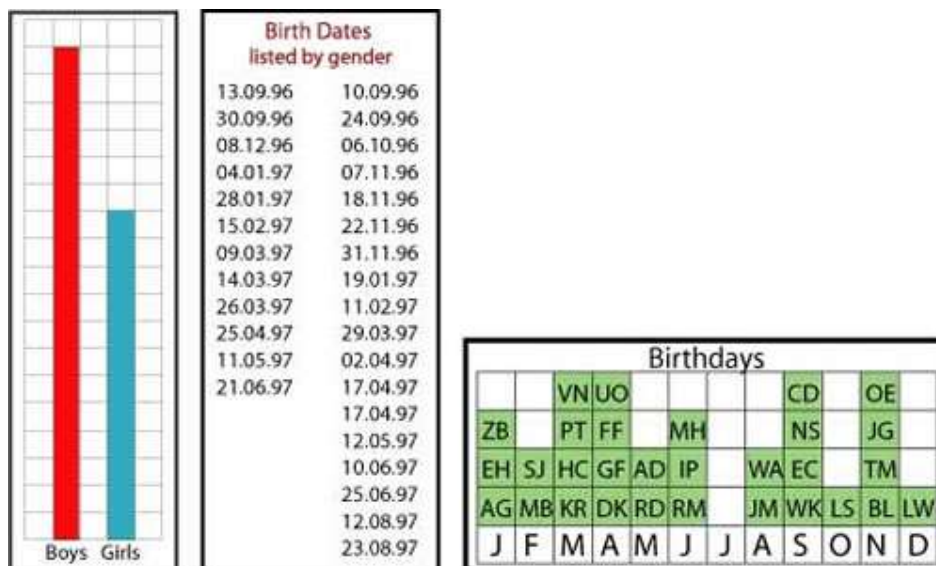
Presenting the Project

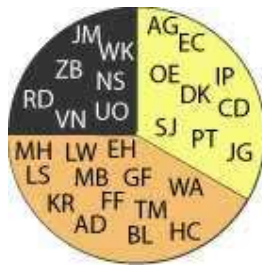


On what day did Class 5 present their work?
